¹These dates apply to full semester courses. Refer to the *eLion* "Course Drop Dates" application for further information. Starting with the first day of the class, a tuition penalty may be charged if the course is dropped.

Registration Instructions for All Students

Undergraduate Students

If you are an advanced standing, first-year, re-enrolled or provisional student, please follow the instructions below for registering: Meet with your adviser and plan your academic schedule. To determine when you may register, consult the registration timetable. This timetable is based on the number of total credits you have earned to date as well as the credits for which you are currently registered. Credits scheduled through the Independent Learning Program or the World Campus do not count in determining your minimum credits to register until grades are recorded. You may register using any of the available registration methods. Complete your registration by paying applicable tuition and fees.

Undergraduate Nondegree Students

There are two categories of undergraduate nondegree enrollment:

- Nondegree-Regular:** Any person having received a high school diploma or its equivalent may be permitted to register as a nondegree regular student. There are no specific enrollment limitations associated with this student status.
 - To enroll as a nondegree student, complete an [Undergraduate Nondegree Enrollment Form](#) and return the form to the Registrar's office at the campus you plan to attend.
 - All nondegree students register on a space available basis.
 - Enrollment as a nondegree student does not imply admission to the University.
- Nondegree-Conditional:** Any student who has been dropped from degree or provisional status by Penn State or any other college or university because of unsatisfactory scholarship may be permitted to register as a nondegree-conditional student. Restrictions are applied to students registering in a nondegree-conditional status.
 - May register for a maximum of 12 credits per semester (audit credits are included in the 12 credit limit).
 - Limited to a maximum of 40 credits while in this status.
 - Must obtain academic advising before registering.
 - Audit credits do not count in determining the student's registration status as a full-time or half-time student.
 - Nondegree-conditional students are not eligible for financial aid; housing in the residence halls might not be available; and other privileges may be restricted.
 - If additional information is needed, contact the [Registrar's office](#) at any campus.
 - Nondegree-conditional students are limited to a maximum of 10 credits of late drop, including any drop credits incurred previously.

Methods of Registering

1. a. eLion Web Registration System

Requires a personal computer connected to Web, using Netscape version 2.0 or higher (or an equivalent browser)

Requires a Penn State Access Account

Hours of Operation: 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 a.m., 7 days a week (Eastern Standard Time)

- b. Students who are new to the University, re-enrolling or returning from a leave of absence and do not have an active Friends of Penn State (FPS) Account, a My Admissions Account, or an active Access Account can create a FPS Account to register for courses using eLion. The FPS Account will only allow students to register for courses using eLion and does not provide access to computer labs or the use of Penn State's e-mail services.

Process:

1. Go to [eLion](#).
2. From the "Choose a Category" list in the left frame select the "Student" option.
3. The "Penn State User Authentication" page will be displayed. Select "Create your Friends of Penn State (FPS) Account."
4. The FPS form will be displayed. Fill in the required information, being sure to follow the "Password Guidelines." When completed, select the "Submit" button.
5. A screen will be displayed requiring verification of information. If correct, select "OK" and you will proceed to the confirmation screen.
6. The confirmation screen displays your userID.
7. You have now established an account to register using [eLion](#).

Students who applied for admission electronically created a "My Admissions Account." This is the same as an FPS account and may be used to register for courses. If you have an established "My Admission Account" **do not** establish a FPS account.

After a first-year student completes FTCAP, a nondegree or re-enrolled student pays his/her tuition and fees, the Penn State Access Account is available. Students will need to go to a [signature station](#) to activate their [Access Account](#) in order to use the full range of services available in eLion and Penn State's computing resources.

2. In Person

Present a completed Registration Drop/Add form to the Registrar's office.

There are certain registration activities that require in person registration, such as:

- Enrolling for more than 19 credits/semester (*Adviser approval required*)
- Enrolling in a closed course (*Instructor approval required*)
- Enrolling in a controlled course (*Department approval required*)
- Enrolling in a course after the 10th day of the semester (*Instructor approval required*)
- Enrolling in a course as "audit" or "satisfactory/unsatisfactory" grading option
- First time enrollment as a nondegree student

Completing Your Registration

The Penn State registration process is **not complete** until [tuition and fees](#) are paid. After students schedule their courses, the [Bursar's office](#) will send an e-mail message to the student's official University e-mail account announcing that the [eBill](#) is available. Regardless of the amount due, [action is required to complete](#) the registration process. For detailed information concerning [your tuition bill](#) please contact the Bursar's office.

Consequences of Incomplete Registration

- Students will not receive grades for courses attended.
- Once classes begin, students cannot add or late drop courses for the current semester.
- Students are ineligible to register for future semesters.
- If receiving student loans, the student may enter a repayment status with lender.
- If receiving student aid, some aid sources may be cancelled and unable to be reinstated at a later date.
- If receiving a Federal Work Study award, the student cannot be hired.
- Faculty are not obligated to provide instruction or administer assessment for the student.
- The University reserves the right to cancel an incomplete registration for failure to pay tuition and fees.
- International students may be out of compliance with the Student Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) federal requirements. For more information contact the [Office of International Programs](#).

Late Registration

All registrations processed after the drop/add period are considered late registrations. The following conditions will apply to students late registering:

- A late registration fee of \$250 will be charged.
- A semester bill must be filed with the [Bursar's office](#).
- Dropping and adding of courses will be permitted until the last day of classes.
- Signature of course instructor(s) required.

After the last day of classes, undergraduate students need Faculty Senate permission to register, add courses, or to complete their registration. Graduate students need Graduate School approval.

Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment allows a former degree candidate to resume degree candidacy. Re-enrollment is appropriate if you:

- Withdrew from the University
- Interrupted continuous degree enrollment during fall/spring semester
- Were dismissed or suspended for non-academic reasons
- Invalidated a leave of absence
- Plan to return for a second associate or baccalaureate degree
- Plan to return for graduation
- Voluntarily changed your enrollment status to nondegree

Graduation Information

To graduate, you must satisfy all the University, college, and major requirements that were in effect at the time of your most recent admission, or re-enrollment, as a degree candidate to the University.

- **It is your responsibility to notify the University of your intent to graduate.**
- This should be done by using the Graduating this Semester [eLion](#) application at the beginning of the semester you plan to graduate. The activation dates for Fall graduation is **August 17** through **September 7, 2009**. Using the "Graduating this Semester" application on [eLion](#), you can set or remove your intent.

After the activation period expires, you must contact the New Kensington Registrar's Office to activate or remove your intent to graduate.

Leave of Absence

The purpose of a leave of absence is to allow students to interrupt continuous enrollment (usually for not more than one year) without having to apply for re-enrollment and without changing conditions of their academic program.

- The deadline for filing a Leave of Absence Form is the last working day prior to the first day of classes for the semester the leave will begin.
- A leave of absence is not required for summer session.
- You will be expected to return to the University according to the conditions of your approved leave.
- If you return to school earlier or later than approved, you must make application for re-enrollment.
- You may not enroll in any Penn State courses.
- You may enroll in courses offered by another accredited institution.
- While on a leave, you can request a continuation of your Penn State access account by filling out the Penn State Access Account Extension for Student Leave of Absence Form. There is a fee for this continued service which is explained on the form.

Weather Emergency Cancellations

In the event of snow, severe storms or other emergencies, official word of closing the campus or delaying classes can be found on the radio stations (KDKA-1020 AM, B 94-FM 93.7 and Y 108-FM 107.9), television stations (KDKA-TV Channel 2 and WTAE-TV Channel 4, the Internet (New Kensington campus homepage), and on personal cell phones.

Cancellation and delay information for students is also available by phone on a pre-recorded message: (724) 334-6006.

Cell phone users who subscribe to PSUTXT, Penn State's text-message alert system, will receive a text message for incidents that may impact the campus community. Students who have accessed eLion since Oct. 8 were automatically signed up for the service. Other students and faculty, staff and the general public need to subscribe online to the free service.

PSUTXT, a one-way communications tool designed to get emergency information to subscribers, was initiated in August 2006 as one means of emergency communication to the University community. The system is used in conjunction with Penn State Newswires and the Penn State Live Web site.

Subscription to PSUTXT is free, although individual cell phone carriers may charge for text messaging. To sign up for the service, visit <http://newswires.psu.edu/> online and follow the instructions at the bottom of the page under the PSUTXT heading.
